An evening filled with dancing, the traditional Politarchopolitan 'light supper', dancing, games, dancing, fun and frivolity, dancing, romance, and more dancing.

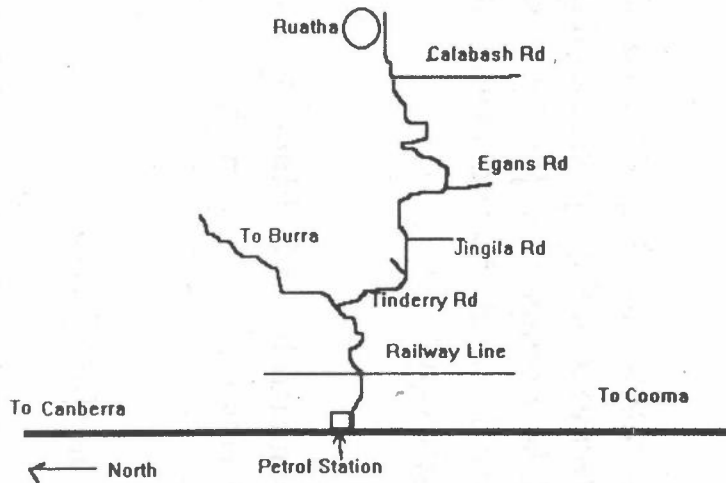
