### Tayles from Events of Recent Past

Newcomer's and Waronial Championships AS 49

The College of St Aldhelm hosted the Newcomer's Event and Baronial Championships for both armoured combat and rapier on Saturday the 15<sup>th</sup> of March 2015 (AS 49). Lady Merione French was the event, and the event was held at the Scout Hall on the corner of Ebden and Hassall Streets, Ainslie.

The Baronial Armoured Championships was fought as a round robin by the six entrants: Sir Ysambart Courtin, Lady Caitlin Dai, Lord Daniel (formerly Daeg of Andronicus), Lord Grimr inn Kyrri, Lord Otto Sexburger and Cossimo. Baron Crispin wanted to see more fighting and so, following the round robin, he tasked the outgoing Baronial Champion, Lord Otto, with holding the field and having all others challenge him to single combat with weapons of their choosing. At the end of the day, Their Excellencies named Lord Otto the victor of the tournament, and Sir Ysambart as the newest Baronial Armoured Champion.

The Baronial Rapier Championships was fought as a partial round robin, with odd rounds fought Curaiss style (metal armour impervious and leather armour cut resistant) and even rounds fought with offhand spoon and weapon specified by the outgoing Baronial Rapier Champion, Don Francois. There were ten entrants: Sir Ysambart Courtin, Don Owain Cantor ap Hughe, THL Ceara Shionnach, Lord Alexander a la Fontayne, Lord Francesco di Falco di Pietro Aviati Vinattiere, Lord Issarn e Tankard dzo Bordonia, Lady Merione French, Lord Owen Fetherston, Lord Lorccan Ruadh and Ida.

Their Excellencies inducted Lord Daniel (formerly Daeg of Andronicus) into the Baronial Guard as an armoured combatant, and They awarded Ida with a cup for being undefeatable with offhand spoon.

The Feast involved plentiful food, much singing, storytelling and a fashion parade that showcased different clothing styles from various times and places. With the War against the Mongol Horde looming, Dis Excellency gave a rallying speech to encourage fighters to join the war book to pledge their allegiance in the coming war.

#### The War to Keep Politarchopolis Free

The War to Keep Politarchopolis Free (otherwise referred to as the Mongolian BBQ) was fought on the 21st of March 2015 (AS 49) at the Tuggeranong Archery Club, 299 Soward Way, Greenway. The autocrats were Jarl Niall inn Orkneyskii, Dux and Duchess Liadan ingen Fheradaig.

The Mongol Horde, led by Linggiyadai Ba'atur Lihagan and Altani Lihaligu Deke Lihatun, descended from the North to strengthen Their new claim over the Barony of Politarchopolis.

Before the battles began and to spur on Dis army, Baron Crispin handed out six lots of griffin feathers to Helena the Innocent, Ulric of Ambeldune, Ginevra Lucia di Namoraza, Myfanwy of Ambeldune, Havelok Outlawe and Henry Radclyfe.

Hinggiyadai Hhagan, Hing of the Empire of Lochac and leader of the Mongol Horde, addressed the Barony with: "I see the look of fear in your eyes. Or, maybe it's ridicule. They're pretty much the same thing."

Politarchopolis started strongly on the war field, taking the first victory. However, this did not last and the Lihagan led His forces to win the next ten battles in a row. Needless to say, Politarchopolis has now been assimilated into the Empire of Lochac. Their Excellencies Crispin and Joan have been appointed by Their Pajesties as Noyan (i.e. commanders of a thousand warriors) under Pax Mongolian (the peace of Mongolia).

### Oltimate Fighter Series

The Ultimate Fighter Series is a Lochac-wide series of tournaments, fought in specified weapons combinations and ranked using a Swiss seeded tournament format. Tournaments have been taking place in the following groups: Politarchopolis, Kowany, Innilgard, Stormhold/Brae Clas, Aneala/Abertridwr, the Porthern Keaches and Pordenvale. Fighters are given points for their ranking in each tournament they participate in, and the top ten ranked (non-belted) fighters across Lochac will be given entry to the final tournament to be held at Great Northern War in the Porthern Keaches (Queensland) in June 2015 (AS 50).

The Ultimate Fighter Series in Politarchopolis are run by Count Sir Berenger of Nancy, who is also the steward of the Lochac-wide Series. In our Barony, there have been rapier tournaments held interspersed throughout the tournament at each Ultimate Fighter event. The rapier tournaments have been organised by Don Owain Cantor ap Hugh and Lord Lorccan Ruadh.

Four of the five tournaments to be held in Politarchopolis have been run to date, and are summarised below. They were each held at the Ainslie Scout Hall on the corner of Hassall and Ebden Streets in Ainslie, ACT. ## Tournament 1 / Sunday 26 October 2014 / Single Handed Weapon Format

Single-handed weapon format, in this context, meant a single sword, dagger, mace or axe - basically no shields or two-handed weapons permitted. #### Missives from the Officers



From the Chronicler

This is the first edition of Griffintayle to be published since September 2011. I have attempted to style this latest release after the layouts of the world's oldest newspapers: Relation aller Fürnemmen und gedenckwürdigen Historien by Johann Carolus in Straßburg (border of France and Germany, 1609) and Aviso Relation order Zeitung by Lucas Schulte in Wolfenbüttel (Germany, 1609). Both were made possible by the 15th century invention of printing presses, which led to mass production of publications by the end of the 16th century. Furthermore, both newspapers included woodcut illustrations, which involve an artist carving an image into a wooden surface and coating this in ink to stamp onto paper. The images used in the new Griffintayle have been traced from the two newspapers listed above, or drawn in the style of the images, by the Chronicler. Neither of these publications used colour, and so colour will be avoided. Hyperlinks will be underlined to make them easily identifiable without detracting too much from the intended style. The fonts used throughout are relatively consistent for this period - ISL Blackletter for certain capitalisations and ISL Ancient for the remaining text.

## People of Politarchopolis

This month, Baroness Ginevra interviewed Guildmaster Don François Henri Guyon - former Baronial Rapier Champion for AS 49 (2014-15):

What is your SCA name and title?

François Henri Guyon. For the rest, see <u>Lochac's Canon Lore</u>.

How long have you been fighting?

I started Heavy combat in 1983. I started Rapier in 1988. I gave up Heavy in 2004 following chronic injuries.

What training regime do you have?

I study twice a week. Exercise 5 days a week. Training once or twice a week.

Who inspires you to fight and why?

No-one 'inspires' me to fight - I fight because I enjoy it. Gurtrud von Ritzebuttel inspires me to do well in my endeavors.

Do you have a favourite training video or book? Which and why?

I have no favorites. I drag out four or five works and compare, no matter the subject. I quite like Mike Loade's videos, and Tudor Monestry farm and Secrets of the Castle.

What fighting accolades do you have?

Order of the white scarf (OWL), Guildmaster of Defence in Lochac. Silver Rapier.

What are your other preferred activities in the SCA?

Spinning, narrow-work, woodwork (Joinery), dressmaking, cooking, Beadmaking (Lampwork). I have recently got into knitting and naalbinding.

How would you respond to a challenge from the champion of another Bharony?

Work out what event to meet them at. Research the other champion (got to give them my best fight). Talk to the Polit B&B about any backstory or approach they wish. Last minute training to hone specific skills.

Do you have any ideas of what sort of championship event you'll hold next year?

I like cuirass tourneys, but spoons have always been special to the Baronesses of Politarchopolis...

What advice do you have to beginners?

Do your homework. Keep your nose clean. The first of anything you try will usually be poor, but repeated attempts bring mastery. Plus, you will never see how good your item is - the creator only ever sees the faults.

The Baron and Baroness are the leaders of the Barony, representing the Crown.

#### Seneschal / Anne de Tournai

The Seneschal is the principal legal representative of the Barony (i.e. group president).

#### Arts and Sciences / Rosamund Laiborn

The Arts and Sciences officer is responsible for encouraging the crafts of the Barony.

# Captain of Archers / Olric of Ambeldune

The Captain of Archers manages the Waronial archery activities (both target and combat).

#### Chandler / vacant

The Chandler is responsible for inventory of Baronial items, including regalia and hospit (i.e. garb to be borrowed by newcomers).

### Chirurgeon / Iseldis of Winchester

The Chirurgeon is responsible for first aid and safety at events.

### Chronicler / Ceara Shionnach

The Chronicler is responsible for the production and publication of the Baronial newsletter, Griffintayle.

#### Constable / see Reeve

The Constable is the primary safety officer at an event, the collector of indemnities, and to administer lost property.

### Hospitaller /Gabriel van Dorne

The Hospitaller works on the recruitment and retention of new members to the Barony.

#### Herald / Antonia Rucellai

The Herald is responsible for acting as the voice of the Baron and Baroness, and for assisting in registering names and devices with the College of Arms.

## Keeper of the Lists / Fionghuine MacCoinnich

The Keeper of the Lists organises, and keeps track of the results of the various martial competitions in the Barony.

## Marshal / Blethyn ap Gryffd

The Marshal is responsible for martial activities in the Barony.

### Rapier Marshal / Lorccan Ruadh

The Captain of Archers manages the Baronial rapier activities.

#### Reeve / Eberhard Neggerstein

The Reeve is responsible for managing the financial reporting of the Barony (i.e. the group treasurer).

### Webwright / Nicodemus Novello


The Webwright maintains the Baronial website.
