Seneschals Report: Draft end of year report passed out for comment, amendments, etc. prior to posting tomorrow. Brief word in peoples ears, not specific hassle, but Monthly Bash's etc are SCA events and the mundanity etc should be kept to a minimum. Let's make a conscious effort - lead by example.

Arts & Sciences: Music group going well. Feast saw some of their efforts. Dance was going well, however exams at ANU have removed venue, will have break over Christmas period. Proposed restart February/ March - to be announced. If want change of day etc tell Amanda - majority will prevail.

Hospitaller: Chests well advanced, when finished will index all items as pack. Need some new table clothes, in Reeve's hands. Propose stitch and bitch to make tabards. Francois raised question of missing elephant platters - commission David to make more. Old ones declared unrecoverable - feeling was if used then should get some more - Michael/ Megan to follow up.

Constable: No voice - no report.

Reeve: \$1429 (even though bank phoned to say overdrawn) will be closing Commonwealth account and opening ANZ through Amanda. New rules make problems, forms have to be posted to Lochac Exchequer etc. Has taken over 7 months so far. Saturday night looks like being a profit.


