Well known as one of the finest and kindest healers of the Kingdom, Mistress Isabella is beloved across the Kingdom. Too many citizens to count have found healing and succour at her hands at Rowany Festival and other events. Her satisfaction with healing the populace of the Kingdom is only matched by her enjoyment of supporting others to have the best possible events, whether that be through her cooking or by stewarding.

Mistress Isabella has been a stalwart and lynchpin of Torlyon for decades, and once Torlyon joined the Barony as a Canton, she has simply becme a lynchpin of Politarchopolis. She has supported the Barony for many years both as an officer and as an organised and indefatigable event and feast steward for events such as Politarchopolis University, St Vitas dance weekend, as well as Kingdom investitures and tourneys.

Maîtresse Kiriel du Papillon is a 16th century widow from France who has settled in the south of Germany.

Maîtresse Kiriel is a founding member of Politarchopolis – the very first event was held in her home. Over the many years of Politarchopolis's history, she has been responsible for running and cooking innumerable events, small and large.

Kiriel ran Lochac's first Vice-regal Investiture, Lochac's first Principality Investiture, and Lochac's first Kingdom Investiture. She has held many Shire and Principality offices and worked as a marshall, arts and sciences officer, and was the first herald in Lochac to be rostered for voice alone.

Maîtresse Kiriel loves the pageantry, colour and creativity that the SCA brings to participants, but also the outright fun that it can provide (examples of her work in this regard include stewarding the anti Valentines feast "the feast of St Wilgefortes", where people who displayed affection were required to wear false beards, and where she herself donned an outrageous moustache to take the role of the Pirate King in a play; and the free Winter games event which included activities such as catching a soap "fish" in a paddling pool of iced water and snow ball fights).

In contrast, First Crown was just one example of the dignity, pageantry and glory of high court events that Maîtresse Kiriel's leadership and imagination has brought into being. It was an example of her ability to inspire and lead, engaging citizens across all of Lochac to achieve a great goal, and her strongest hope is that the Barony will allow her to dedicate herself to help lead them as Baroness with similar energy and dedication.

Although Maîtresse Kiriel was absent from the Kingdom for some years, she remained in close contact, during that period. Since her return ten years ago she has been an active member of the

Barony and has run many events in the Barony, and catered and assisted with cooking with even more. Even during covid lockdowns Kiriel continued to contribute to the SCA, teaching zoom cooking classes across the known world.

Maîtresse Kiriel has been recognised in Politarchopolis as a founding member of the Order of the Cordon Rouge, holds a Politarchopolis Fellowship of Grace, two Burley Griffins (one for service, one for A&S), a Baronial Cypher, and is a free citizen of the Barony.
