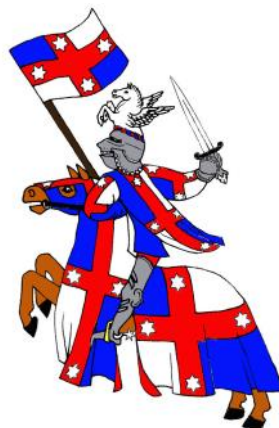
From these three categories one who is local to Politachopolis and Her Cantons shall Be Our New Champion chosen .
