So, in preparation – let me say a big thank you to those who have responded to my initial Survey. We have had a good result! So this is a reminder to fill out this “amended” form. The new form includes “contact information”. Master Crispin will reach out to those who have indicated that they will eat with the Polit Food Fund.

I will also reach out to others who indicated they will assist with Campsite Set up and management. Thank you so much in advance. Organising the Polit encampment is a huge task!!!

Rowany Festival - Politarchopolis Campsite Food Fund information! 🍎 🥕 🥔 🥛

If you would like to be in the Polit campsite food fund please contact me (Crispin).

Note that if you are camping in the Politarchopolis campsite you don't have to be in the food fund, and there are some people who will be in the food fund who are not camping in the Politarchopolis campsite.

Food Fund pricing per person:

- * Sunday is set up day - no food provided, recommend going into town for dinner!
- * Monday breakfast to final Tuesday breakfast: \$150
- * Monday dinner to final Tuesday breakfast: \$140
- * Tuesday dinner to final Tuesday breakfast: \$125
- * Wednesday lunch to final Tuesday breakfast: \$115
- * Thursday dinner to Monday lunch: \$81
- * Individual meals: \$7
- * Children eat for half price.

Every adult in the food fund will need to work one or two full meal shifts throughout the event (depending on how much of the event they'll be there for). This involves preparing the food, serving it and cleaning up afterwards. Approximately 2 hours per shift at breakfast and lunch, and 3 hours at dinner.

Rough outline of meals:

- Breakfast: eggs, bacon, bread, fruit, porridge.
- Lunch: meat, salad, bread, cheese, pickles, nuts.
- Dinner: stew, vegetable dish, bread and a dessert.
- Snacks: biscuit, fruit, cordial.

Will attempt to cater for special food needs on request (e.g. dairy/gluten/veg/allergies).

Fighting, feasting, costuming, crafting, music, dance... if it was done in pre-17th century Europe, we know someone interested in recreating it.

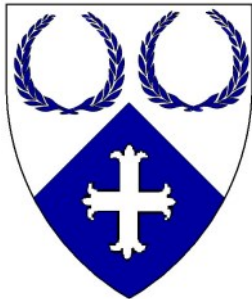

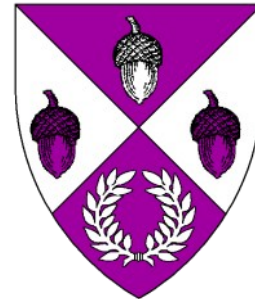
